

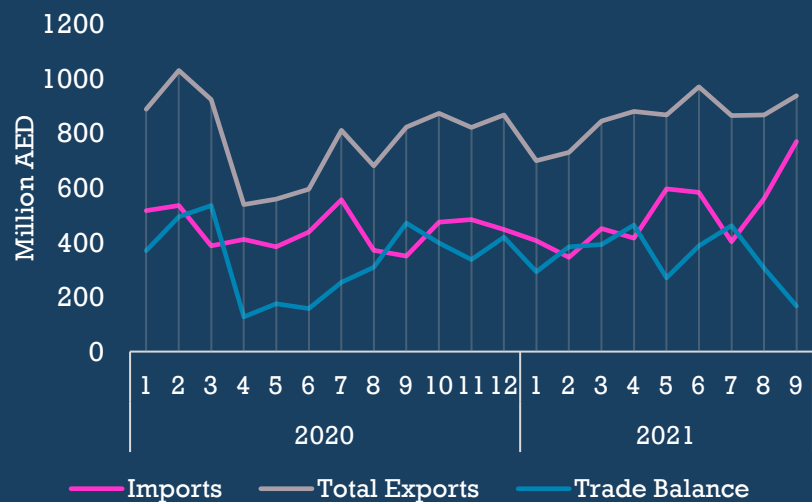
Foreign Trade Report

Third Quarter - 2021

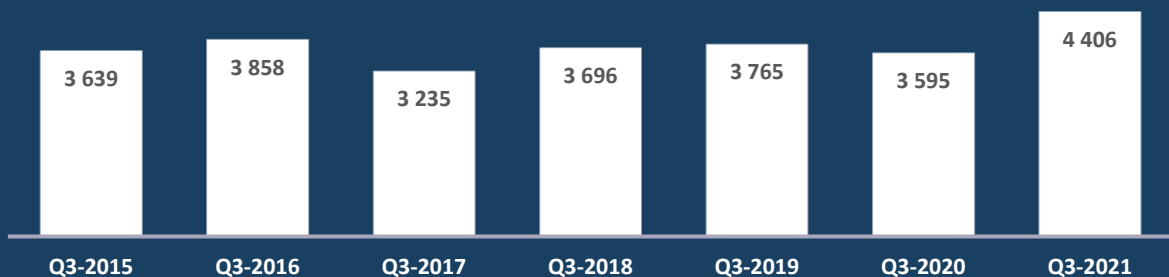
Main Points:

- **4,406** million dirhams is the size of total trade in Ras Al Khaimah in the third quarter of 2021
- **61%** share of total exports in total trade
- **39%** share of imports in total trade
- **23%** increase in the trade size compared with the same quarter in 2020
- **15%** increase in total exports compared with the same quarter in 2020

A quarterly bulletin issued by Ras Al Khaimah Center for Statistics and Studies, contains foreign trade data received from the Customs Department in Ras Al Khaimah, which includes foreign trade data made through the emirate's ports.

Introduction

Foreign trade Statistics are important statistics, they enable the production of a wide group of statistical indicators that show movement of goods that entered or exited from emirates ports (Marine, land, and air). The department of customs in Ras Al Khaimah is the main source of the data, as it monitors the trade movement through 12 custom centers in the emirate.

The data in the report, covers all the trade movement through the emirate's ports to the outside world; it does not include trade transactions of Ras Al Khaimah done through the ports in other emirates.

The center has adopted the general trade system in producing trade data based on international

recommendations to adopt this system to produce the data.

The center extends its sincere thanks to the customs department in Ras Al Khaimah for its full collaboration with the center in providing the data to produce the foreign trade statistics.

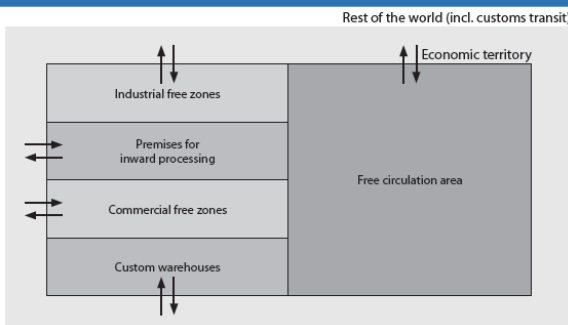

- "-" = The value equals zero.

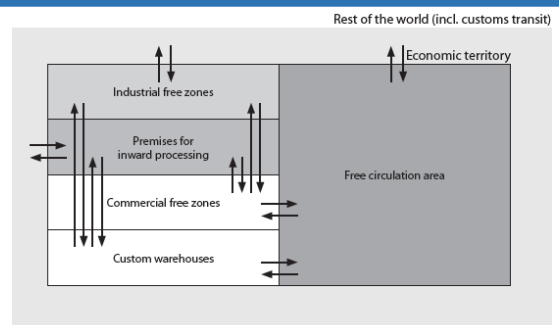
Concepts and Terminology

- The economic territory: is the area under the effective economic control of a single Government in which it gets things done effectively.
- The General trade system and the Special trade system: The general trade system is in use when the statistical territory in a country coincides with the economic territory. while the special trade system is in use when the statistical territory comprises only a particular part of the economic territory.

General trade system



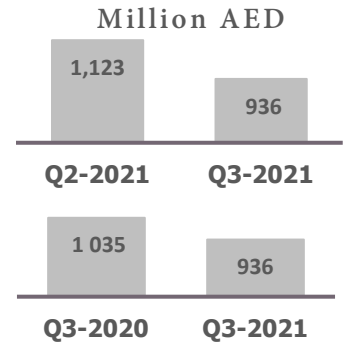
Special trade system



Trade Balance & Imports

Trade Balance

The trade balance has a surplus of 936 million dirhams in the third quarter of 2021, decreasing by 17% in comparison with the second quarter of the same year, and has decreasing by 10% in comparison with the same quarter of the previous year.



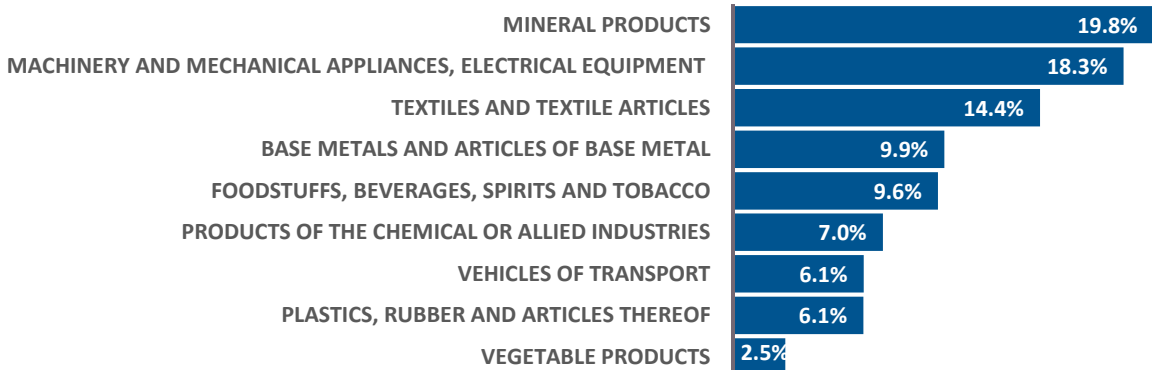
Imports

The total imports were 1,735 million dirhams in the third quarter in the 2021 comparing it with 1,596 million dirhams in the second quarter of 2021, increasing by 9%, and comparing it with the same quarter of the previous year, the data showed that the increase was approximately 36%.

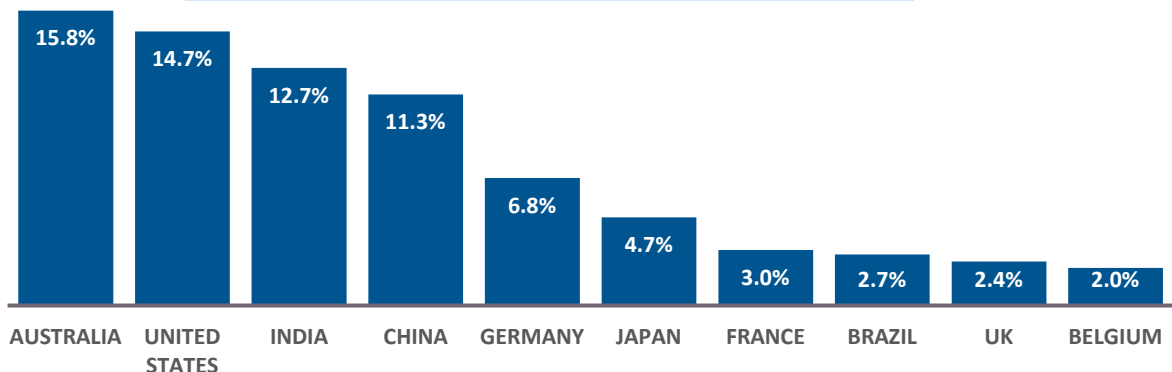
As for the country of origin, 16% of the imports were from Australia, 15% from United States and 13% from India.

As for the types of the imported goods, the data showed that the imports of mineral products were in the first place with a value of around 343 million dirhams followed by the machinery and mechanical appliances and electrical equipment with 318 million dirhams and Textiles and Textile Articles products with 250 million dirhams.

Imports By Main Trade Partner-Q3-2021



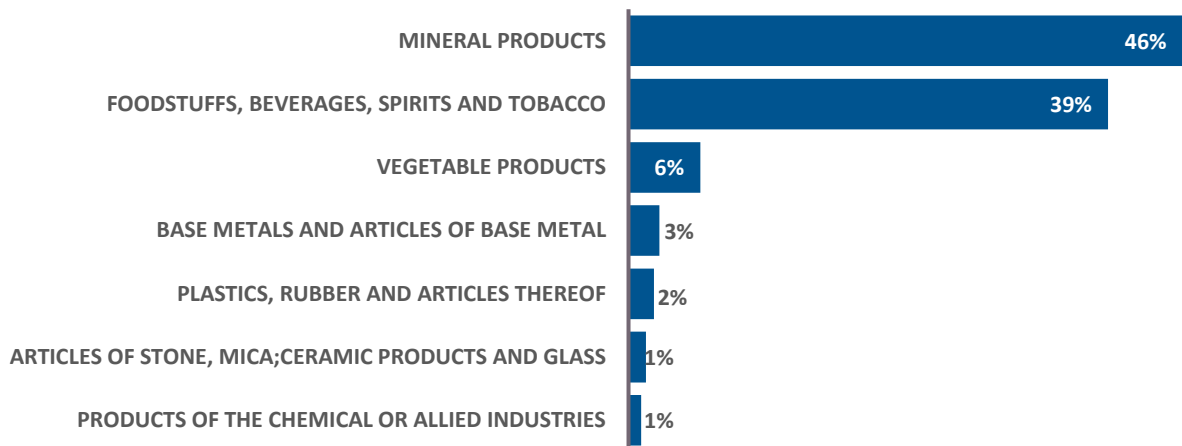
Exports

In comparison with the second quarter of 2021, exports decreased by 4% in the third quarter of 2021 and reached around 2,300 million dirhams in the third quarter. By comparing it with the third quarter of the previous year (2020), it increased by 16% where the total exports were 1,989 million dirhams in the third quarter of 2020.

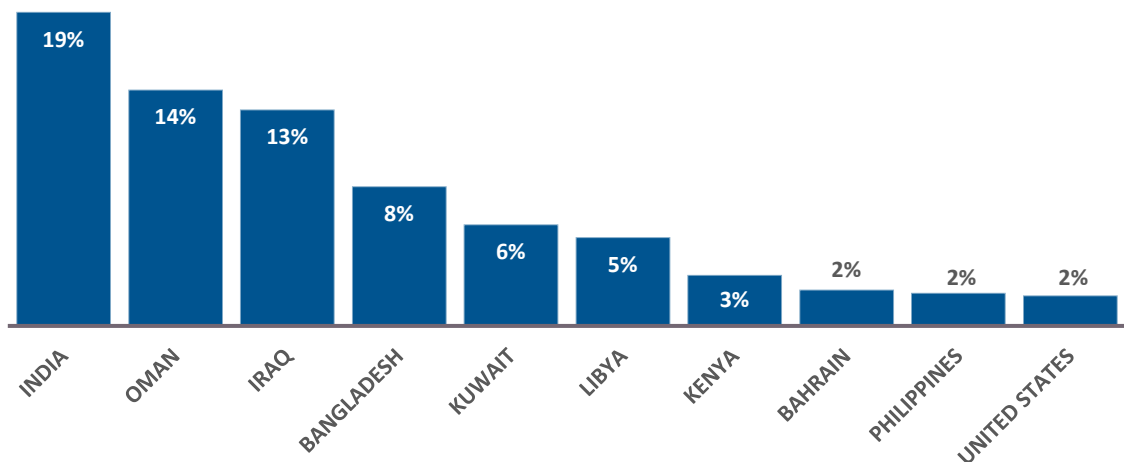
The data showed that most of the exports were in the mineral products, the exports of this group were around 1,049 million dirhams, followed by foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and tobacco products with 908 million dirhams.

Based on the destination, exports to India were 19% in the third quarter of the year, exports to Oman were 14%, and exports to Iraq were 13% of total exports.

Exports By Main Trade Partner-Q3-2021



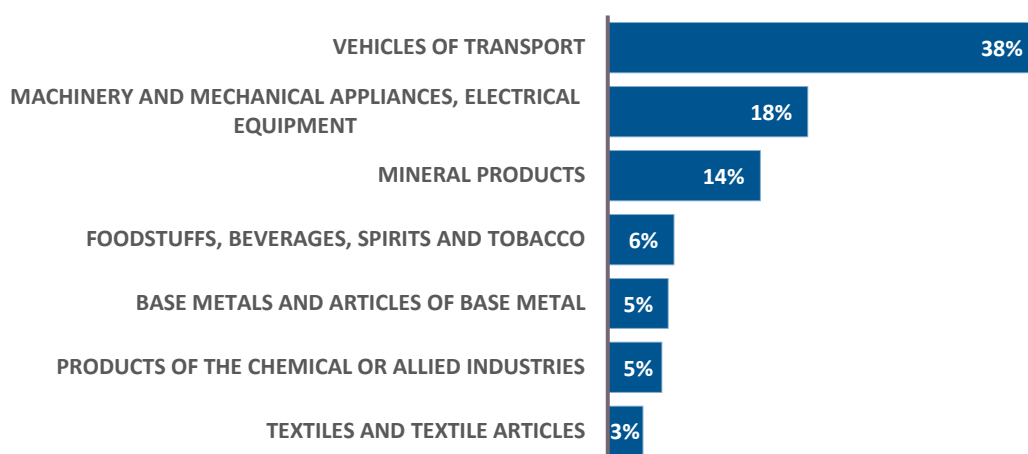
Re-exports

In the third quarter of 2021, the total of re-exports were around 371 million dirhams, increasing by 16% in comparison with the previous quarter (Q2 - 2021). By comparing it with the second quarter of the previous year, data shows that there is an increase in re-exports by 14%.

The data showed that re-exports of vehicles of transport were 143 million dirhams and of machinery and mechanical appliances, electrical equipment were around 66 million dirhams.

Based on the trade partner, out of total re-exports, the re-exports to Oman were 54%, to Chad 9%, and to Saudi Arabia 7%.
