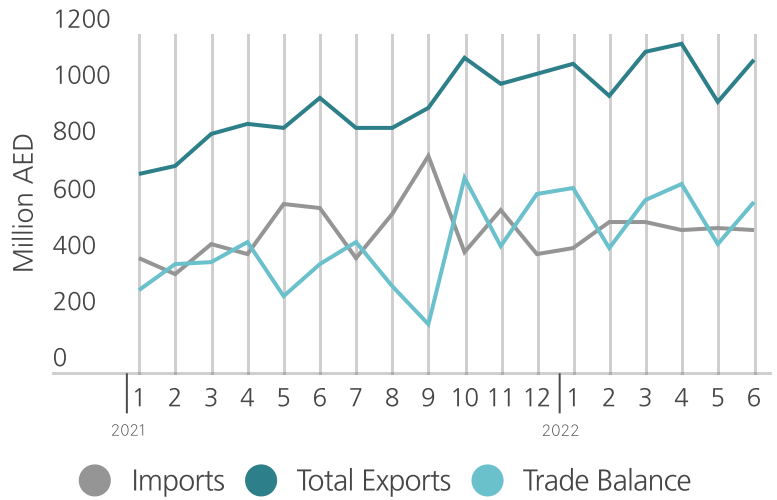
Second Quarter 2022



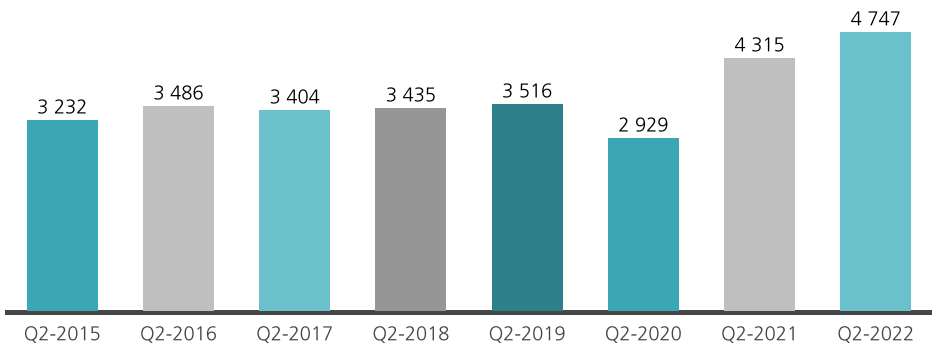
A quarterly bulletin issued by Ras Al Khaimah Center for Statistics and Studies, contains foreign trade data received from the Customs Department in Ras Al Khaimah, which includes trade movement data made through the emirate's ports.

Main Points

Introduction

Foreign trade Statistics are important statistics, they enable the production of a wide group of statistical indicators that show movement of goods that entered or exited from emirates ports (Marine, land, and air). The department of customs in Ras Al Khaimah is the main source of the data, as it monitors the trade movement through 12 custom centers in the emirate.

The data in the report, covers all the trade movement through the emirate's ports to the outside world; it does not include trade transactions of Ras Al Khaimah done through the ports in other emirates.

The center has adopted the general trade system in producing trade data based on international recommendations to adopt this system to produce the data.

The center extends its sincere thanks to the customs department in Ras Al Khaimah for its full collaboration with the center in providing the data to produce the foreign trade statistics.

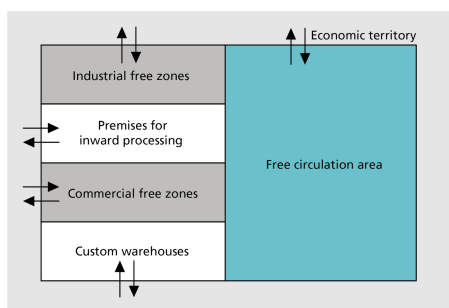

- "-" = The value equals zero.

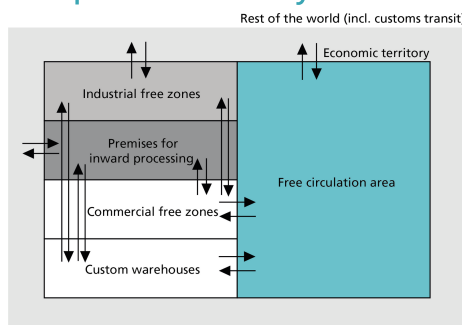
Concepts and Terminology

- **The economic territory:** is the area under the effective economic control of a single Government in which it gets things done effectively.
- **The General trade system and the Special trade system:** The general trade system is in use when the statistical territory in a country coincides with the economic territory. While the special trade system is in use when the statistical territory comprises only a particular part of the economic territory.

General trade System



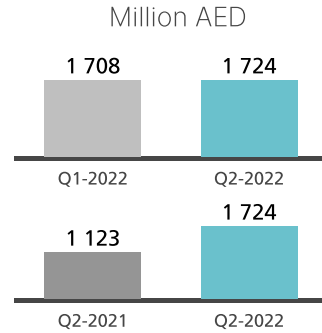
Special trade system



Trade Balance & Imports

Trade Balance

The trade balance has a surplus of 1,724 million dirhams in the second quarter of 2022, increasing by 1% in comparison with the first quarter of 2022, and has increased by 53% in comparison with the same quarter of the previous year.

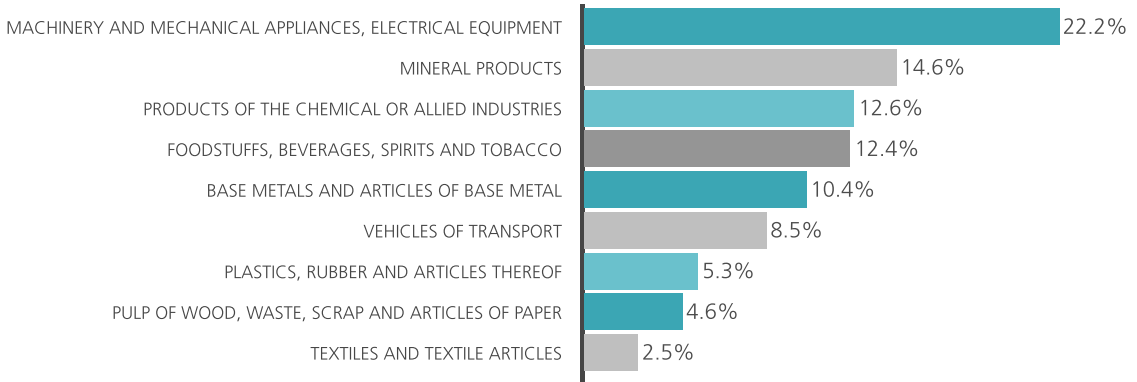


Imports

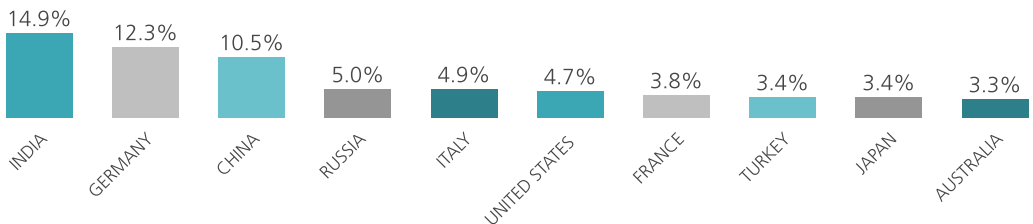
The total imports were 1,512 million dirhams in the second quarter in the 2022 comparing it with 1,505 million dirhams in the first quarter of 2022, increasing by 0.4%, and comparing it with the same quarter of the previous year, the data showed that the decreasing was approximately 5%. As for the country of origin, 15% of the imports were from India, 12% Germany and 11% from China.

As for the types of the imported goods, the data showed that the imports of machinery and mechanical appliances and electrical equipment were in the first place with a value of around 336 million dirhams followed by the mineral products with 220 million dirhams and products of the chemical or allied industries 190 million dirhams.

Imports by Main Trade Partner - Q2 - 2022



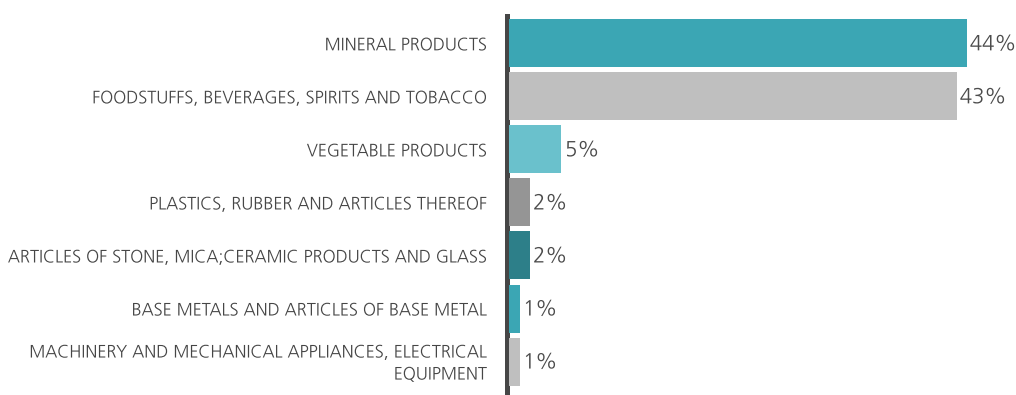
Exports

In comparison with the first quarter of 2022, exports decreased by 2% in the second quarter of 2022 and reached around 2,608 million dirhams in the second quarter. By comparing it with the second quarter of the previous year (2021), it increased by 9% where the total exports were 2,399 million dirhams in the second quarter of 2021.

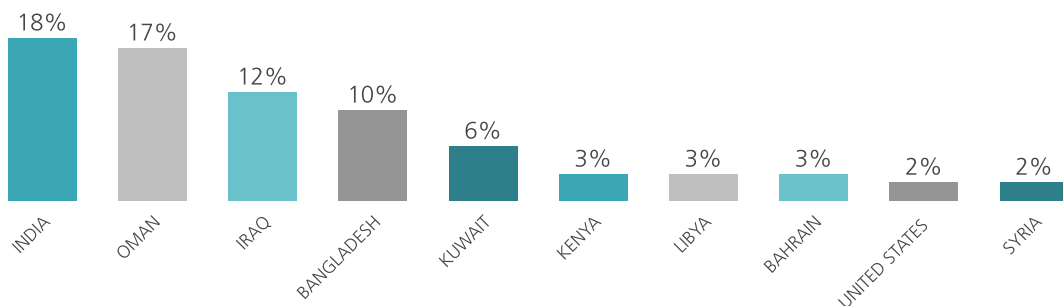
The data showed that most of the exports were in the mineral products, the exports of this group were around 1,155 million dirhams, followed by foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and tobacco products with 1,124 million dirhams.

Based on the destination, exports to India were 18% in the second quarter of the year, exports to Oman were 17%, and exports to Iraq were 12% of total exports.

Exports By Main Trade Partner - Q2 - 2022

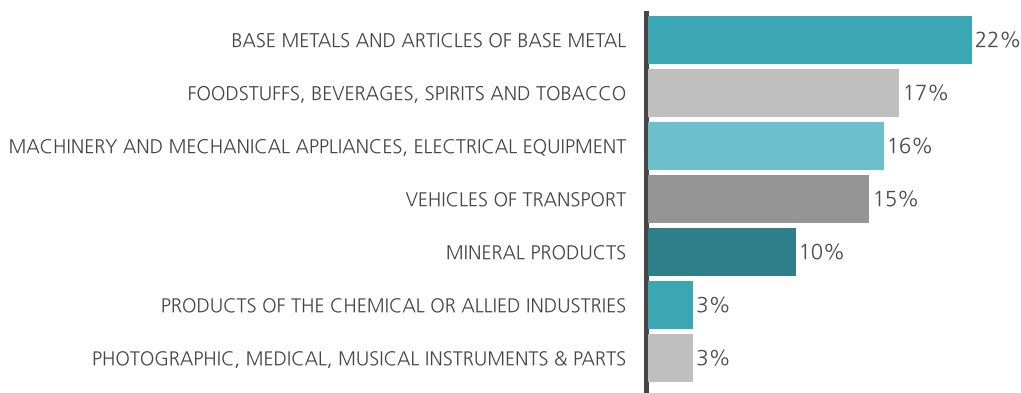


Re-exports

In the second quarter of 2022, the total of re-exports were around 627 million dirhams, increasing by 13% in comparison with the previous quarter (Q1 - 2022). By comparing it with the second quarter of the previous year, data shows that there is an increase in re-exports by 96%.

The data showed that re-exports of base metals and articles of base metal were 139 million dirhams and of foodstuffs, beverages, spirits and tobacco were around 107 million dirhams. Based on the trade partner out of total re-exports, the re-exports to Oman were 44%, to China 19%, and to Cameroon 5%.

- **Data source:** Data of customs transactions from the Customs Department in Ras Al Khaimah.
- **Methodology of the data production:** The data was produced based on the General System of Foreign Trade.
- **Coverage:** The data contains all the transactions of importing, exporting, and re-exporting, done through the customs ports of Ras Al Khaimah, therefore, the data in this report does not include the foreign trade data of the emirate of Ras Al Khaimah done through other emirates.
